



Japanese Chin Club of America Mentor Agreement

The parent club's responsibility to educate those that seek information and knowledge on their breed from a qualified mentor is a venture not to be regarded lightly.

- A parent club member who is in good standing for a minimum of eight consecutive years and has bred a minimum of five litters whelped in their household along with producing five Japanese Chin that are AKC Champions.
- Adherence to all club rules and Code of Ethics set forth by the parent club in all areas of conduct and breeding practices and has demonstrated the ability to be a positive and productive ambassador of the breed.
- To be knowledgeable and respectful at all times of the current Japanese Chin Club of America breed standard.
- All mentoring sessions shall be conducted in an impartial manner with restraint from promoting individual breeding programs and / or promotion of individual dogs or bias toward other breeding programs.
- It is understood that various styles in the breed would be appropriate to discuss, however, presented in an unbiased and educational form.
- Provide dogs for educational programs and workshops when requested and available without financial compensation.
- Availability to present club approved programs and workshops.
- At least one attendance at a Judges Educational Seminar on the Japanese Chin Standard, *including* Hands On Workshop.
- Participation and attendance in at least one out of every four years in scheduled National Specialty Japanese Chin Judges Educational Seminar. Participation in National Specialty Judge's Education formal mentoring ringside sessions, and workshops when available. Failure to comply could result in removal from the mentoring program.
- *Any infraction of the agreed upon conditions as is known, proven and brought to the attention of the Judge's Education Committee shall result in removal from the Mentor Program.*
