

# JCCA Policies and Guidelines

## JCCA Approved Mentors/Presenters

1. Must be able to communicate with others in a clear and thoughtful manner.
2. Must meet qualification A **OR** B below:
  - A. Must be a member in good standing with the JCCA, have at least six years total JCCA membership, have bred five litters of Japanese Chin whelped in their household, and be breeder of record of four AKC Champion Japanese Chin.
  - B. Must be a member in good standing with the JCCA, have at least six years total JCCA membership and be an AKC judge of the Japanese Chin.
3. Must have attended an educational seminar on the Japanese Chin standard.
4. Must be recommended by either the JCCA president or the JCCA Education Chair, and voted upon by the JCCA board. Potential mentors who meet requirements 2A or 2B may also apply directly to the board using a board-approved application.
5. Presenters for JCCA educational seminars will use the JCCA-approved breed presentation. The President or Education Chair may appoint additional persons to mentor or act as a seminar presenter on a one-time basis prior to board approval as a parent-club approved mentor. The Education Chair may arrange for assessments of presentations.
6. Mentors/Presenters should have the ability to discuss the breed without prejudice toward individual breeding programs or lines.
